osteoporosis - patient education - osteoporosis osteoporosis, or porous bone, is a disease from the loss of bone mass and bone tissue. people may not know that they have osteoporosis until their bones become so weak that a sudden strain, bump, or fall causes a bone fracture. osteoporosis usually occurs after menopause.
